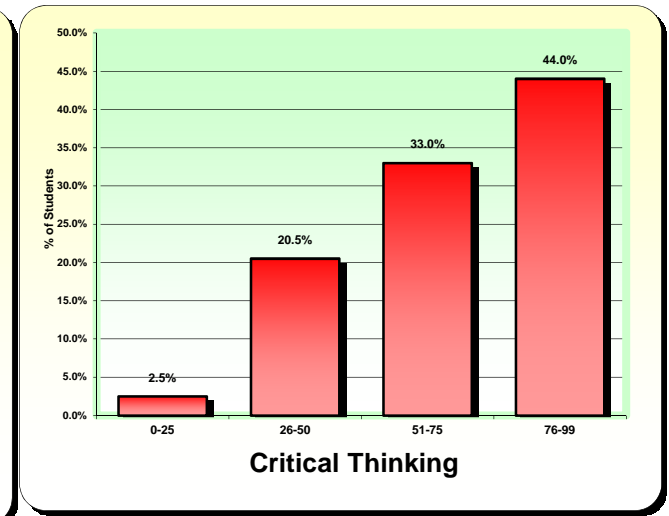
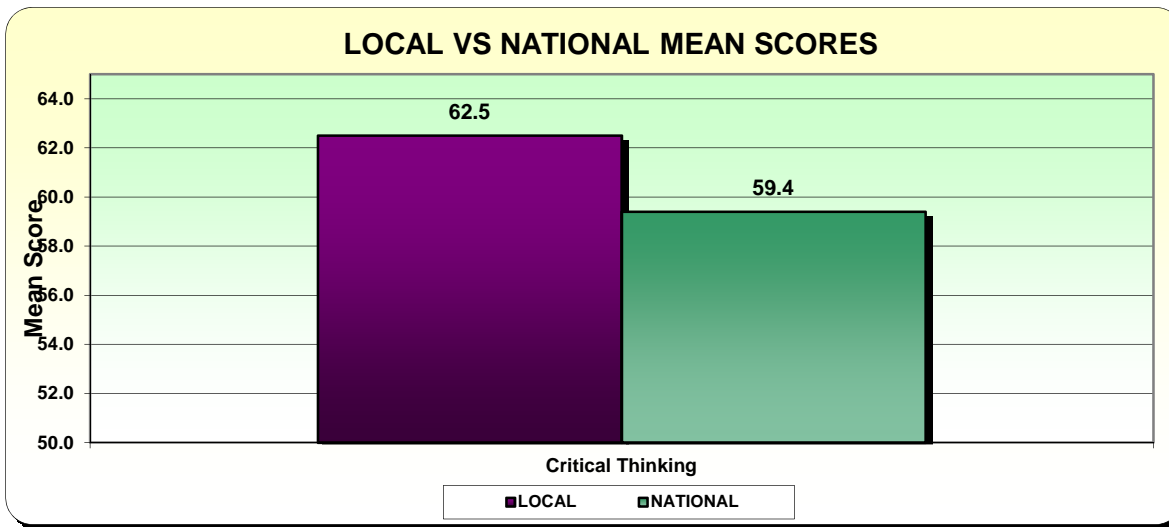

ACT's Collegiate Assessment of Academic Proficiency (CAAP) was administered at Southeastern in March 2015. The CAAP is a standardized, nationally normed assessment that helps institutions evaluate their general education outcomes. It was administered in a total of 13 capstone courses or senior level seminar courses across all majors. One modules were administered across the courses, Critical Thinking. Overall, 200 students participated in this assessment.
