THE DEPARTMENT TODAY. The results of the last Exit Survey show that graduates from the department are well satisfied with the quality of their education. We believe that the exit survey is effectively measuring the attitudes of undergraduate and that only minor emendation; largely dealing with changes within the department, need to be made at this time.

Graduates in Speech Education take the University survey with additional 9 survey questions, numbered 45-53, largely concerned with problems of secondary teaching. In the last report there were 3 graduates in Speech Education. Because of the small number of graduates in Speech Education, the results may be considered tentative and not necessarily representative. No changes in the Speech Education questions are being considered at this time.
