

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMPUS



BEDROOM

- Bed sheets (all halls are XL twin sized except the apartments which are full Sized)
- Comforter
- Blankets
- Pillows/pillowcases
- Mattress pad
- Clothes hamper
- Clothes hangers
- Storage containers
- Area rug
- Lamp(s) + bulbs
- Television + remote
- Picture frames
- Mirror
- Garbage can
- Curtains hung w/ a tension rod ONLY
- Small fan
- Air purifier
- Dehumidifier

CLEANING SUPPLIES

- Disinfecting wipes
- Air freshener
- Multipurpose cleaner
- Laundry detergent
- Dryer sheets
- Glass cleaner
- Mop/bucket or spray mop
- Broom + dustpan
- Toilet brush
- Bathroom cleaner
- Dish sponges/dish soap
- Moisture absorbing products (ex: DampRid, etc.)

KITCHENETTE

- Plates, cups, bowls
- Utensils/silverware
- Can opener
- Chip clips
- Zip-top bags
- Food storage containers
- Refillable water bottle
- Coffee maker w/ automatic shut off
- Crockpot w/ automatic shut off
- Rice cooker
- Air fryer w/out pressure cooking feature
- Paper towels
- Garbage can
- Garbage bags
- Mini fridge up to 5 cubic feet
- Microwave 1000 watt maximum
- Ascension, Twelve Oaks, and Southeastern Oaks Apartments have a fridge + microwave provided by University Housing. Duplicate appliances will cause electrical issues in the room.

BATHROOM

- Towels + wash cloths
- Shower caddy
- Toilet paper
- Shower curtain, liner, + hooks
- Bath mat/rug
- Toilet plunger
- Shower shoes/flip flops
- Bathrobe
- Toothbrush holder
- Small garbage can

STUDYING

- Calendar/planner
- Laptop + accessories
- iPad + accessories
- Printer
- Paper
- Ink
- Scissors/stapler
- Calculator

MISCELLANEOUS

- Surge protector (major appliances must be plugged into a wall outlet only)
- Umbrella/rain jacket
- Coat
- First aid kit
- Batteries
- Bicycle w/ lock for bike rack
- Dry erase/message board
- Flashlight
- Cell phone + charger
- Headphones
- Prescription medications
- Lockbox
- ATM, debit, credit card
- Driver's license/student ID
- Insurance card
- Renter's insurance (optional)

TIP: Contact your roommate to avoid bringing duplicate items.

WHAT NOT TO BRING TO CAMPUS



This list is not exhaustive, but includes some of our most frequently encountered prohibited items.

FURNITURE + MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

- Sofas, loveseats, futons, hammocks + recliners
- Upholstered cushioned lounge chairs
- Chairs w/ wheels or casters
- Extension cords (***may use surge protectors, but major appliances must be plugged into a wall outlet only***)
- Non-university issued mattresses
- Air mattresses
- Bed risers made of plastic, metal, wood, cinder block, or PVC pipe
- Pets (except for 1 non-dangerous freshwater fish in a vessel no larger than 1 gallon)
- Nails and screws (***thumbtacks may be used instead***)
- LED wall lights that use adhesive or mounting tape
- Wallpaper + other adhesive stickers of any kind
- Any adhesive backed strip or hook (command hooks, strips, mounting tape, putty, etc.) (***thumbtacks may be used instead***)
- Free weights, dumbbells, pull-up bars, exercise equipment that attaches to door frames
- Stationary bikes, weightlifting benches, elliptical machines, rowing machines, etc.
- Window tint adhesive
- Electric coasting devices, including, but not limited to scooters, skateboards, and hoverboards (see University Coasting Devices Policy)

PROHIBITED APPLIANCES

- Space heaters, kerosene/propane heaters
- Cooking appliances w/ exposed heating elements, open flame, or those using grease
- Pressure cookers, including instant pots
- Toaster, hot plate, coffee pot w/out automatic shut off
- Halogen/torch style lamps
- Window unit air conditioners
- Bidets
- Personal mini-fridge and microwave not permitted in Ascension, Twelve Oaks, and Southeastern Oaks Apartments

INCENDIARY ITEMS

- Candles/incense
- Lighters, matches, strikers, torches, kerosene/oil lamps
- Fireworks and other explosives
- Gasoline, lighter fluid, and other flammable liquids
- Propane
- Sterno or other denatured alcohol solids
- Gas fueled machinery



STRICTLY PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Alcohol (Residents of Southeastern Oaks Apartments who are 21 years of age or older are permitted to possess and/or consume alcohol in their individually assigned bedroom. If all residents of the apartment are at least 21 years old, residents may possess and/or consume alcohol in the common areas of the apartment.)
- Kegs, funnels, and empty alcohol containers
- Illegal drugs

Southeastern Louisiana University is a gun-free zone.

- Ammunition and firearms of any kind, including, but not limited to lethal firearms, non-lethal or less-than-lethal firearms, BB, pellet, airsoft guns, and toy guns
- Weapons of any kind, including, but not limited to tasers, mace, batons, clubs, switchblades, and knives with a blade longer than 5 inches

Southeastern Louisiana University is a smoke-free and tobacco-free campus.

- Cigarettes
- Pipes
- Hookah products
- Electronic cigarettes
- Vape pens
- Oral tobacco products

Tampering with, covering, or disconnecting smoke detectors, sprinkler heads, or any fire safety equipment is a safety violation and may result in disciplinary action.
