Goal 2

Essay about teaching a particular issue of writing process.

B. Expected Outcome

Students will be able to demonstrate knowledge of the noninstructional aspects of education such as growth and development, learning theories, history and philosophy of public education and technology for the classroom.

Assessment

95% of the graduates will score at least 645 on the Professional Knowledge portion of the NTE.

Goal 3

To provide students the necessary skills to engage in scholarly research in the area of English.

A. Expected Outcome

Majors should be able to write a coherent, persuasive essay that is well organized and developed, grammatically correct, and stylistically appropriate for a diversity of occasions.

Majors should be able to analyze intelligently and critically both prose and verse.
