B. Expected Outcome

Assessment

The percent of students answering "Agree" or "Strongly Agree" on the Computer Information Management, Entrepreneurship and Small Business Management, General Management, and Human Resource Management Concentration Surveys should be at least 61%.

C. Expected Outcome

Students will be able to demonstrate managerial competencies in planning, organizing, and controlling organizational resources in one of four concentrations.

Assessment

The percent of students answering "Agree" or "Strongly Agree" on the Computer Information Management, Entrepreneurship and Small Business Management, General Management, and Human Resource Management Concentration Surveys should be at least 61%.

D. Expected Outcome

Students will develop essential leadership skills such as interpersonal skills, oral and written communication skills, and problem-solving skills.

Assessment

- a. The percent of students answering "Agree" or "Strongly Agree" on the Department of Management Senior Survey and the Addendum to the Southeastern Alumni Survey should be at least 61% indicating an acceptable outcome.
- b. The score on the Instructor's Assessment of Senior Student Performance should at least be "Agree"

E. Expected Outcome

Students will be able to apply technology for the purpose of organizational management and problem solving.

Assessment

- a. The percent of students answering "Agree" or "Strongly Agree" on the Department of Management Senior Survey and the Addendum to the Southeastern Alumni Survey should be at least 61% indicating an acceptable outcome.
