

Longitudinal Enrollment

Southeastern's total student enrollment increased by 3.1% from the Spring 2023 semester to the Spring 2024 semester. This reflects an increase of 2.2% in undergraduate enrollment and a 14.2% increase in graduate enrollment. Graduate enrollment includes students in Alternate Certification Programs.



Minority Enrollment

The enrollment of minority students decreased slightly to 28.0% of total enrollment compared to 28.8% in Spring 2023.

Average Course Loads

The average course load of undergraduate students is 10.8 hours which is the same as Spring 2023. The average course load for graduate students (including Alternate Certification students, Master's plus 30, and Extended Studies students) is 7.5 hours, which is an increase from 7.3 in Spring 2023.

Freshmen Cohort ACT Scores

The average ACT Composite score decreased from 22.0 in Spring 2023 to 20.2 in Spring 2024.

Full-time Equivalent (FTE) Students Taught

The number of full-time equivalent (FTE) students taught increased 2.9% from the Spring 2023 semester to the Spring 2024 semester. (Note: These FTE calculations are based on the undergraduate and graduate hours taught by departments. These calculations will differ from FTE calculations based on the student classification of undergraduate and graduate.) The number of full-time equivalent undergraduate students equals the total undergraduate student credit hour (SCH) production divided by 12, and the number of full-time equivalent graduate equals the total graduate SCH production divided by 9.

Top Six Parishes



With 3,350 students, St. Tammany is the most represented parish. Compared to Spring 2023, St. Tammany Parish had the largest increase (30.5%) in undergraduate enrollment. Tangipahoa had the largest increase in graduate students with an increase of 11.1%.
